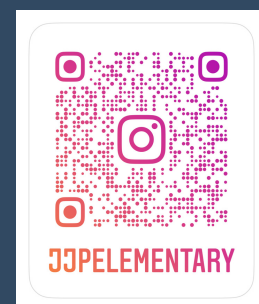

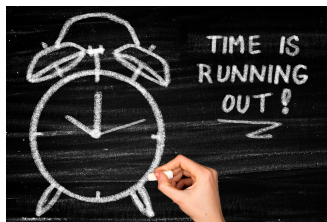

THE DOS, THE DON'TS, AND THE RULES

Dear Judy Jacobs-Parkway Parents,

Having our carpool plan is a privilege at JJP, and is run through the PTA with the cooperation of our wonderful staff who assist with arrival and dismissal.

While we encourage, and suggest, that all children ride the bus to school whenever possible, we know that our carpool lane does provide a source of convenience- however, we need to make sure we respect and follow procedures to make it safe for all of our children, parents, and staff.

DO:

- Make sure your child can **INDEPENDENTLY** buckle and unbuckle their own seatbelts.
- Make sure your child **ONLY** enters and exits your car **CURBSIDE**.
- Make sure you have your carpool number visible when you pull up on the carpool line.
- Make sure you are courteous and wait your turn. Three numbered spots are used as designated entrance areas. You will be directed to pull into those numbered spots when it is your turn.

DON'T:

- Ø Do not walk through the carpool lane or get out of your car.
- Ø Do not stay in your carpool spot after your child has entered the building.
- Ø Do not smoke in the carpool lane.
- Ø Do not try and pass the vehicle in front of you. Please wait for everyone to pull in and out of the carpool lane in order.

CARPOOL RULES:

Morning Arrival

- Children may **NOT** be dropped off before 9:05 AM
- You do **NOT** need your carpool number for drop off

Afternoon Dismissal

- Children may **NOT** be picked up before 3:20 PM
- You **MUST** have your carpool number for dismissal
